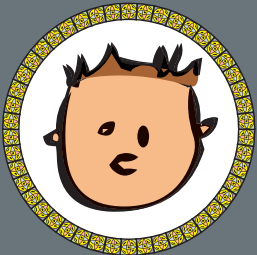
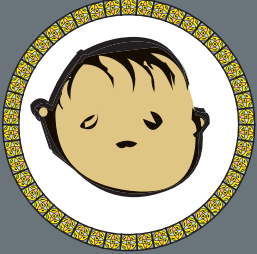
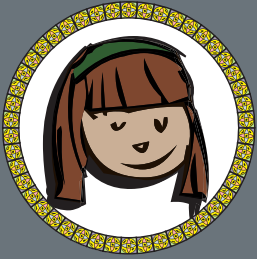


Learning Disabilities Association of Toronto District
